Antioch Sheffield – 1 Position Available

1) Worship Pastor – This is a full-time, self-funded position, with secondary responsibility as associate college pastor.

Antioch Waco – 9 Positions Available

1) Assistant Communications Director – This is a full-time position. Applicant must have degree in communications, media or related field, or at least five years' experience in communications, be organized and able to manage multiple projects in a fast-paced environment. They will work in tandem with the communications director and team to create consistency in messaging from the front door to the back door, create communication strategies, oversee written materials related to assigned projects and proactively work to make sure Antioch and AMI maintains an effective presence on the web, including style/presence, search engines and new technology.

2) Community Outreach Administrator – Responsibilities include, providing administration for the Community Feast and for the Benevolence ministry. They will also help with Community Outreach Pastor administration, as able. This is a part-time position, and the hours are 8:30 a.m. – 1 p.m., Monday – Friday.

3) Facilities Special Projects Staff – This position includes producing and overseeing production of special resources for church departments including physical spaces, furniture and event props. Maintain organization of the shop area. Maintain the church golf carts, the lift, church tools and equipment. Assist other Facilities and Maintenance Department members with event setup, janitorial needs, grounds care or equipment and material relocation. Report to Director of Facilities regarding all special projects, expected completion date and any operation issues. This is a part-time position.

4) Facilities Team Members - Needs to be available to work all of the special events that may fall on a weekend and that is in addition to normal scheduled weekend hours. Needs to be able to lift 10 pounds regularly and 30 pounds occasionally. Should be self-motivated, of high moral character, be at work and working at the scheduled time, manage time well to accomplish required tasks, very detailed oriented, enjoys serving others and is teachable. This is a part-time position.

5) Mercy House Night Monitor – This is a sleeper position, and compensation is room and board. This person would serve as the staff presence in the evening, overnight and early morning. Be available to process the day with the men as opportunity provides and assist with conflict when needed. This position would be around 19 hours a week.

6) Grace House Night Monitor – This is a sleeper position, and compensation is room and board. The times required are: Monday – Thursday from 9 p.m. - 8:45 a.m. (Can be flexible with Lifegroup night), Friday at 11 p.m., Saturday from 11 p.m. – 8:15 a.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. – 8:15 a.m. This person will also be responsible for assisting as a back-up for coaches in crisis situations (rarely happens) during your time on.

7) 2 Junior High Associate Youth Pastors – These individuals will actively participate in prayer, collaboration, planning and strategizing with youth staff, as well as assist with overseeing special

events, mission trips, etc. Provide pastoral oversight to students, parents and leaders, and help coordinate weekly services. This is a part-time position (20 hours a week).

8) Youth Worship Leader and Service Coordinator – This person will be responsible for leading worship and worship team(s) for junior high and high school services, as well as assist in the development and production for weekly services. Actively participate in prayer, collaboration, planning and strategizing with the youth staff. Build relationships with students and actively participate in youth leadership team pre-meetings and other gatherings.
